- ✓ Secondary tenses mid/pass endings: -μην, -σο, -το, -μεθα, -στε, -ντο
- ✓ Augment is added to the secondary tenses. It is usually an epsilon ($\hat{\epsilon}$ -) before a consonant; alpha/epsilon becomes eta ($\hat{\eta}$) and omicron becomes omega ($\hat{\omega}$).

Imperfect mid/pass indicative inflection of λύω and its meaning

έ λυόηην	I was being loosened
ἐ λύου	you (s.) were being loosened
ἐλύ∈το	he/she/it was being loosened
ἐ λυόμ ε θα	we were being loosened
ἐ λύ ε σθ ε	you (pl.) were being loosened
ἐλύοντο	they were being loosened

Adverbial καί -- "also" or "even"

- σὺ πιστεύεις ὅτι εἶς ἐστιν ὁ θεός, καλῶς ποιεῖς καὶ τὰ δαιμόνια πιστεύουσιν καὶ φρίσσουσιν. (James 2:19)
- ἐλθέτω ἡ βασιλεία σου· γενηθήτω τὸ θέλημά σου, ὡς ἐν οὐρανῷ καὶ ἐπὶ γῆς· (Matt 6:10, "Let your kingdom come, let your will be/happen/take place ①as in heaven and on earth; or ②as in heaven—even on earth." AWP)
 - o KRV나라이 임하옵시며 뜻이 하늘에서 이룬 것 같이 땅에서도 이루어지이다
 - Thy reign come: Thy will come to pass, as in heaven also on the earth.
 - o NIV your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
 - o NRS Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
